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What is AADE?



American Association of Diabetes Educators (AADE):

- Membership Organization our 14,000+ membership base is made up of Diabetes Educators. Diabetes Educators are healthcare professionals and paraprofessionals, ranging from RN's, RD's, CDE's, Pharmacists, PhD's, and more)
- National Accreditor for Medicare- AADE is one of two certifying body Diabetes Self -Management Education (DSME) programs, a requirement to bill for Medicare. AADE accredited programs are called "DEAP" sites. (ADA programs are "ERP").



Why is AADE in Diabetes Prevention?

In 2015, AADE's National Practice Survey Found: 80.5 % of respondents reported to be working with people with prediabetes 80% of DEAP programs reported to be doing some sort of prevention programming

Only 0.4% reported receiving reimbursement for prevention services





CDC chose AADE for National DPP Scaling (DP12-1212)

Insights After 3+ Years of Delivery:

Pro's:

- Costs seem to be comparable to other large in-person DPP providers
- AADE DPP's are meeting or exceeding DPRP requirements
- Our programs seem to have high rates of physician referral compared to others since they are already connected with local physicians in their DSME work and tend to have feedback loops already in place
- Should have a streamline ability to bill for Medicare Reimbursement when available

Challenges

AADE DPP Program Coordinators usually do not have the time, skills, contacts and resources to "sell" the program to new payers



Coverage and Cost of AADE DPP

All AADE DPP sites are receiving some type of DPP reimbursement Cost of AADE DPP is comparable to other large in-person DPP networks

Additional Coverage Information to Consider:

- AADE DPP set up for billing and tracking- CPT Code: 0403T
- USPSTF Grade B
- AADE DPP Sites already billing Medicare for DSME and preparing for Medicare coverage of DPP coverage as of January 2018 (tentative)



AADE DPP in Virginia- Potential to Scale

Virginia has 55 DSME Sites that could implement the National DPP (12 DEAP and 43 ERP) Each one of these sites may be able to serve the National DPP in multiple locations

The American Association of Diabetes Educators Diabetes Prevention Program (AADE DPP) is part of the National Diabetes Prevention Program, led by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). This DPP program is proven to prevent or delay type 2 diabetes in at-risk patients.

ADE DP sites implement the National DP, an avidence based program that reduces the risk of developing type 2 diabetes by SBX. The structured illestyte change program delivered by ADE DPP sites results in weight loss by feaching participants how to set realistic goals on reducing calories and increasing physical activity.



At least 18 years old:

Have a BMI greater than or equal to 24; greate

- than or equal to 22 if Asian; Have established risk factors for developing
- type 2 diabetes;
- OR have been previously diagnosed with gestational diabetes.
