

TOPIC: Medicaid Coverage of Diabetes Self-Management Education and Support (DSMES),

Part 1: Obtaining Coverage

Two states (MS and CO) will discuss how they have obtained coverage for DSMES (also referred to as DSME/T and DSME) for their Medicaid populations. Two presenters from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention will provide an overview of DSMES and avenues to obtain Medicaid coverage, respectively.
